MISSION

The mission of the CFSO is to speak with a single voice on behalf of its member organizations in matters of mutual interest regarding forensic science, to influence legislative matters and public policy, and to make a compelling case for greater funding for public forensic science service providers and forensic medicine service providers.

PURPOSES

- A. To increase essential resources for the forensic science enterprise
- B. To promote initial and ongoing accreditation and individual practitioner certification resources
- C. To advance the validity, reliability, and reproducibility of forensic science and forensic medicine practices
- D. To improve and expand forensic information technology systems, infrastructure, and interoperability
- E. To advocate for enhanced forensic science research and development, and advancement of a national strategy
- F. To maintain effective and timely communication with our member organizations

OBJECTIVES

- A. To continue to be recognized as the organization representing the forensic community to policy makers
- B. To collaborate with federal entities to promote increased grant funding for administrative and quality systems
- C. To identify and promote opportunities to meet the current and expected demand for qualified practitioners
- D. To advocate for ongoing professional development of forensic practitioners and support services
- E. To establish and maintain collaborative partnerships for validation and performance verification studies
- F. To interact with federal grantors for simplification of the grant application and management process
- G. To maintain a collaborative relationship and consensus on common objectives among CFSO organizations
